DESCRIPTIONS

General - short:

Experience and learn about the indigenous wild cats of South Africa on one of the conservation-based guided tours. Guests' support funds the wildlife rehabilitation facilities.

General – full:

Tenikwa started as a small wildlife rehabilitation facility which has grown to be a well-recognised and conservation-driven wildlife centre. The centre offers a variety of guided tours to raise awareness about the indigenous wild cats of South Africa and human-wildlife conflict with local wildlife. The prime source of funding for the rehabilitation work that Tenikwa carries out, comes from guests visiting the Awareness Centre, or staying in the on-site accommodation. The centre has a coffee shop, souvenirs and credit card facilities.

Individual Activities

The Wild Cat Experience – a 1 hour guided tour to see the indigenous wild cats of South Africa and other local wildlife, learning about their status in the wild and the conservation efforts underway to keep healthy populations in the wild;

The EcoKidz Family Challenge – a 90-minute fun-filled eco-activity for the family where Tenikwa's guides keep the children engaged with eco-topics and introduce them to the wild cats of South Africa. This program includes a booklet (in English) for each participating child and Pledge Certificate.

Tours are individually conducted per family group,





The Private Tour – a leisurely private tour which is ideal to experience and photograph the indigenous wild cats of South Africa with ample time to enjoy and learn about the characteristics of each cat and take amazing photographs with your own private guide. Duration 2 hours;

Forest and Fur – Explore the wonders of the indigenous Tsitsikamma Afro-montane rainforest on the private forest reserve with a knowledgeable guide who will introduce guests to the history, cultural uses, birds and flora of the forest during a leisurely walk along historical logging paths. See also the indigenous wild cats of South Africa and other local wildlife during the wildlife tour, while ending the Forest and Fur experience with a delicious picnic lunch of freshly prepared treats;

Cats in Conservation – A full day experience including breakfast and lunch to gain full appreciation of the work undertaken by Tenikwa with wildlife rehabilitation. Guests get to observe the activities of the rehabilitation facilities, partake in enrichment programs for the non-releasable animals, and generally enjoy the day with the animal keeping staff.

TERMS & CONDITIONS

Child policy

- No charge for children under 4 years for the Wild Cat Experience, EcoKidz and Private Tour;
- For the Wild Cat Experience, EcoKidz and Private Tours, children between the ages of 4-12 years are charged at Child rate. Children over the age of 12 years are charged at Adult rate;
- Children under 9 years old not allowed to participate in the Cats in Conservation Program;
- The Forest and Fur program is not recommended for children under 4 years old.

Other

- Please be at the venue 15min. prior to start of the tour;
- Clients will have to sign indemnity form before partaking.

Driver / Guide

- Drivers/Guides welcome to join free of charge on The Wild Cat Experience, The EcoKidz Family Challenge and The Private Tour. Subject to availability.



BOOKINGS, PAYMENT & CANCELLATIONS

Rates

- In South African Rands; per person;
- May not be published below public rates unless the price is hidden as part of a package;
- Subject to change in government taxes / levies.

Direct bookings / Agents / Operators:

- Full prepayment 7 days prior to arrival.

Cancellation Policy

- If cancelled 30+ days prior to arrival, no cancellation fee;
- If cancelled within 30 days prior to arrival: cancellation fee of 25% of booking value.

Covid-related cancellation:

- Bookings may be cancelled free of charge at any time if:
- The guests are not permitted to travel due to government regulations by either RSA or clients country of residence;
- Airlines decide to halt operations to RSA during the time of intended travel;
- Proof of a travel advisory against RSA;
- A mandatory quarantine period is imposed by RSA or guest's country on return which was not in place at time of booking;
- Proof of guest contracting Covid or in quarantine or under medical treatment up to 48 hours prior to travel;
- Tenikwa has a medical incident related to Covid and is forced to close temporarily.

DIRECTIONS



Tenikwa is approximately 20min. outside Plettenberg Bay, to the east of the town (towards Gqeberha/Port Elizabeth). Car hire must be pre-arranged and is available at Cape Town International Airport, George Airport, Plettenberg Bay Airport and Gqeberha/Port Elizabeth Airport.

Driving from George / Plettenberg Bay (~1h45min./120km./75mi. from George; ~25min./25km./15mi. from Plettenberg Bay):

- From George (Airport) take the N2 National Highway eastwards towards Knysna / Plettenberg Bay / Gqeberha/Port Elizabeth;
- Drive through Plettenberg Bay and continue approximately 20km./12mi. towards Gqeberha/Port Elizabeth on the N2;
- Look out for a big Tourism Signboard that says “Monkeyland, Birds of Eden, Elephant Sanctuary, Tenikwa”. Turn right at the Kurland Village Turnoff which is opposite this sign;
- Continue on this district road (Forest Hall Road) and keep left when the road forks. (If you go down Animal Alley, you’ve gone the wrong way. Turn around and at the T-junction, turn right). The road is signposted for Tenikwa;
- You will pass a little Stone Church on your right;
- You will pass Kurland Village on the left-hand side and the soccer fields on the right-hand side;
- The road will become a gravel road. Where the road forks, take the right-hand fork. Signposted again;





- Approximately 900m. further along the Forest Hall Road, you will see the Tenikwa signpost on the right-hand side. Turn right here to get to Tenikwa's reception. (Gravel road approximately 1.2km only).

Driving from Gqeberha/Port Elizabeth (~2h30min./240km./150mi.):

- Drive approximately 2 hours from Port Elizabeth (recently renamed Gqeberha) on the N2 National Highway, passing Humansdorp, Jeffreys Bay and Storms River in the direction of George / Cape Town;
- Continue along the N2 and drive through the N2 Toll Gate at Tsitsikamma;
- Approximately 20km. / 12mi. past the tollgate, look out for the R102 to Natures Valley;
- Drive past this turnoff, and take the next turnoff to the left, which is signposted as Kurland Village. Tenikwa is also signposted on the N2 for this turnoff;
- Continue on this district road (Forest Hall Road) and keep left when the road forks. (If you go down Animal Alley, you've gone the wrong way. Turn around and at the T-junction, turn right). The road is signposted for Tenikwa;
- You will pass a little Stone Church on your right;
- You will pass Kurland Village on the left-hand side and the soccer fields on the right-hand side;
- The road will become a gravel road. Where the road forks, take the right-hand fork. Signposted again;
- Approximately 900m. further along the Forest Hall Road, you will see the Tenikwa signpost on the right-hand side. Turn right here to get to Tenikwa's reception. (Gravel road approximately 1.2km only).

Driving from Cape Town (~6hrs./~530km./~330mi.):

- Take the N2 National Highway from Cape Town to George, and drive approximately 5 and a half hours on the N2 past Swellendam, MosselBay, George, Wilderness, Knysna, Plettenberg Bay;
- From George / Plettenberg Bay, follow the directions as above.
